Thank you for your interest in working as a volunteer/CIT at Mount Shepherd this coming summer. Mount Shepherd is a ministry of the United Methodist Church. We seek to provide a place where children, youth and adults can grow in the Christian faith. Being a United Methodist is not a requirement for being a volunteer/CIT applicant.

The role of a volunteer/CIT is very important. The volunteer/CIT provides a necessary service to both the campers and staff. And, yes, you get to have a lot of fun too!

Enclosed are the following: application; job description; reference forms; camp schedule. Please read the job description carefully. If you feel qualified to be a volunteer/CIT and this is what you believe God wants you to do please complete the application and return it as soon as possible. Decisions about which applicants are accepted are made as applications are received. Please note: the successful applicant must have attended at least one week of camp as a camper at Mount shepherd. Attendance must have occurred within two years of application. Also, approved applicants must attend the training session on June 11, 2010 from 9 a.m. to noon.

The decision to accept a person as volunteer/CIT is based upon the following:

- Age
- Maturity as exhibited in the answers to the questions on the application
- Skills
- Availability of space for volunteers/CIT's
- Recommendations of volunteers/CIT's
- Fulfilled requirement to attend at least one week of camp as a camper prior to volunteering

Fees to work as a volunteer/CIT are as follows:

- One week: \$125
- Two weeks or more: \$100/week
